Observation Expectations

When you observe you are expected to follow these expectations.

Dress code:

- Khaki pants
- Solid color polo style shirt, tucked in
- Closed-toe shoes (athletic shoes are permitted)
- No perfume
- Fingernails should be short and clean
- Limit to small personal bag, there is no storage for your items

Professional Behavior:

- NO food, drinks, or gum in patient care areas
- NO cell phones, cameras, any electronic devices in patient care areas
- NO physical contact with patients
- NO interruptions during patient sessions, keep all questions after the session
- NO profane and abusive language
- Act professional
- Treat others with respect

Attendance:

- Arrive on time for your scheduled observation
- Missed time cannot be rescheduled
- If scheduled over the lunch hour, please confirm lunchtime with your primary therapist
- You will only be allowed to observe in your approved designated department/area
- You will only be allowed to observe with approved designated personnel
- You are not allowed on campus wearing/ using a TCH badge or wearing TCH logo apparel outside of your approved observation schedule

If you do not follow the expectations above, you will be asked to leave the premises immediately and you will NOT receive credit for the hours completed.
